



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What happens during a color analysis?

When you arrive, you'll get comfortably seated with a mirror in front of you. I'll be behind you with a series of fabric color samples that I'll place over your shoulders to frame your face. Together we'll look at which colors are most congruent, harmonious and flattering with your skin, hair and eye tones.

After a brief set up where we cover your shoulders and torso with a white cape (like when you get a haircut) to minimize distractions, we hone in on your skin tone and eye color. We'll start with silver and gold and then move to additional colors. The goal is to identify a family of colors (your own palette, so to speak) which make you radiant.

After we've determined your best palette, we'll walk through how to use the samples you'll get. They will help you create outfits from your closet and make shopping easier.

What do I get?

Wearing colors that are congruent with your own eye, hair and skin tone – brings out your best. You'll be glowing and radiant.

As your wardrobe evolves and becomes more customized to the colors in your palette, you can expect to feel fabulous and vibrant – like the colors are just right. You'll notice:

- Brighter eye color
- Clearer (verses greyed-down) skin
- Fewer shadows and lines
- More defined chin line

This results is more complements plus you'll feel more confident and that energy emanates into the world.

In addition, your own palette means everything goes with everything else, making it simpler to get dressed and to mix and match items. Shopping is easier. Having to make fewer decisions about what looks great removes a potential stressor from a full, busy life.



Why can't I wear colors outside of my palette?

You can wear any color you want! It's the clarity, shade, tone and tint that influences what's best for each of us. When you wear ones that are less congruent with your own appearance, your:

- Skin looks more uneven, blotchy and washed out
- Mouth contour is less defined and the color is less healthy
- Eyes appear to sink more deeply into their sockets
- Chin line is less distinct

The color can overpower you. Your head and the color can look disconnected.

Where do you work?

Color analysis takes place in a light filled studio in Jefferson Westside neighborhood in Eugene.
